NEW PRODUCTS

MAE - MacroAssembler Editor from Eastern House Software is now available for PEDISK II owners. The famous MAE package is a full feature machine language development system tool that even includes a WORD PROCESSOR. It is now available for all 32K PEDISK II owners (V5 up) for \$169.95. Purchase from your Microtech dealer, Eastern House Software, or directly from Microtech.

PAPERMATE - a full feature word processor is now available for PEDISK II (V4 up). This program, written in BASIC, provides a simple and easy to use stand alone word processor. Originally written for the Commodore disk, it has been converted by Bob Freeman of AB Computers. The price is \$60,00 and it may be purchased from a Microtech Dealer, AB Computers, or directly from Microtech.

KM3 - KM3 was the original disk operating system for the PEDISK I. It is now available as an alternative for PDDS II directly from Wilserve Industries, P.O.Box 105, Haddonfield, N.J.08033.

KM3 PASCAL - Wilserve Industries also offers a version of PASCAL for PEDISK II Systems. This subset of standard PASCAL provides a PASCAL source editor: P-code compiler: P-code interpreter: run time package and floating point capability. It is available from AB Computers: Wilserve Industries or directly from Microtech. KM3 PASCAL requires the KM3 DOS.

fullFORTH+ - a full feature FORTH system for PEDISK II. It offers an interpreter, a cross-compiler, a conditional assembler, string handling, floating point, and a built in screen editor. FORTH is an extensible high level language that allows creation of a custom vocabulary (a custom language). It also allows the inclusion of machine language for time critical pieces of code. fullFORTH+ is available from your dicrotech dealer, from IDPCo., or directly from Microtech at a cost of \$75.00.

PDOS UPDATE!

A new "PROGRAMMER'S MANUAL" is now available for PEDISK Systems. This manual is intended primarily for machine language programmers and provides many details of the inner workings of PDOS II. Complete with many examples as well as listings of some of the PDDS subroutines, this manual is a must for those who are working on custom PEDISK II software. This manual is available to all registered PEDISK owners for \$10.00. It is available from your Microtech dealer or directly from Microtech.

VERSION 5 is the latest! Your revision number can be determined by checking the number on your Master Disk. Here's how to decode: P232V5-6 The first two characters, P2, indicate a version for PEDISK II. Disks marked P1 are for PEDISK I. The second two characters, 32, indicate memory size. In this case-32K. The second two characters, 32, indicate the version number. V5 is current. The last number after the dash indicates compatibility) -3 means 5 1/4" disk, BASIC 3.0 (Update ROMS) -4 means 8" disk, BASIC 3.0 (Update ROMS) -5 means 5 1/4" disk, BASIC 4.0

-6 means 8" disk/ BASIC 4.0

Version 5 software is available to registered PEDISK owners by sending \$25.00 along with their MASTER REGISTRATION NUMBER directly to Microtech. This revision requires both a new ROM and a new diskette.
